Already we have:

- Built resilient online and offline communities.
- Established communications at the highest levels, including with DCMS, No 10, House of Lords Communications Committee, House of Commons Select Committee, All Party BBC Group, All BBC Campaigns Group, BBC, BBC Trust & other key players.
- Influenced the debate and consultations in Parliament, the BBC and wider media.
- Undertaken with academic support our own Independent Inquiry into accountability by the BBC and then published and promoted our findings & recommendations.
- Responded to hundreds of queries & concerns about the BBC.
- Developed analysis & research, raising awareness on the true place and impact of the BBC in society.
- Kept our membership abreast of key developments.
- Successfully campaigned against content & service cuts and highlighted threats of forthcoming cuts.

What's Next

But there is still much to do. Our priorities for 2017 include:

- Lobbying the new Chair and Unitary Board of the BBC, when they are all appointed, to establish how the BBC will be held accountable by the license fee paying public (something that remains unclear currently - 'The Missing Link').
- Continuing our campaigns to minimise further proposed cuts to BBC programmes, services, content, production & websites.
- Highlighting the social, cultural, educational and economic impact of the BBC (ensuring it is not viewed solely on a balance sheet).
